As we all continue to address more extreme, unpredictable climates and rainy seasons, San Bruno is working hard to ensure we are doing our part to maintain clean water in our region.

Unfortunately, the results of the most recent stormwater infrastructure study show the City's stormwater system is inadequate. The City must upgrade and properly maintain the system to ensure efficient drainage, prevent property damage from flooding, and minimize pollution into San Bruno Channel, the San Francisco Bay, and local water supplies.



DEAR NEIGHBOR,

Nothing is more important than the safety and security of our local properties and what we do together to maintain our region's resources for future generations.

Properly maintained stormwater infrastructure protects San Bruno Channel, the San Francisco Bay, and water supplies from contamination. Locally, we must continue to address rainy season flooding that causes residential and commercial property damage in San Bruno.

In these financially uncertain times, it is critical that deferred repairs to our Stormwater System are made in order to protect residential properties and businesses from flood damage.
