



## NOTICE OF OFFICES AND NOMINATIONS AND MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that pursuant to § 10224.5 of the Elections Code of the State of California, relating to the General Municipal Election to be held in the City of San Bruno on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, the following officers are to be elected:

Mayor of the City Council (Full term of two years)

One (1) City Council Member representing District 2 (Full term of four years)

One (1) City Council Member representing District 3 (Full term of four years)

I, Lupita Huerta, City Clerk Elections Official certify I have furnished nomination papers to the incumbent for the open office of Mayor of the City Council. Due to districting, there is no eligible incumbent for either of the following open offices: (1) the office of the City Council Member representing District 2; and (2) the office of the City Council Member representing District 3.

Nomination papers may be obtained by appointment with the City Clerk’s Office located at San Bruno City Hall, 567 El Camino Real.

Completed nomination papers may be filed by appointment with the City Clerk’s Office at 567 El Camino Real between the dates of July 15, 2024 through August 9, 2024 and between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that the following measure question will be voted upon by the qualified electors of the City of San Bruno on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 at the General Municipal Election:

Shall City of San Bruno measure be adopted to repair deteriorating storm-drains, preventing failure, flooding, water pollution/ sinkholes; repair potholes/ city streets; upgrade fire stations, improving emergency response, accommodate modern firefighting/ lifesaving emergency medical equipment, function during earthquakes/ natural disasters; authorizing \$102,000,000 in bonds, at a tax rate of 3¢ per \$100 of assessed value, while bonds are outstanding, initially generating \$3,300,000 annually, without funds for administrators/ cannot be taken by the State of California, with citizen oversight/ independent audits?
